



FINANCIAL POLICY

Thank you for choosing Roaring Fork Oral Surgery and Dental Implants. Our team is committed to providing financing options that work with your budget so you can get the care that you need.

- The cost of your treatment plan is presented at the time of your consultation. If you are receiving treatment on the same day as your consultation, we will present the cost of your proposed treatment prior to your procedure.
- Payment is due in full at the time of service unless a written Financial Agreement has been made between you and the Practice. We accept cash, checks, credit cards, debit cards, and HSA cards.
- We also accept CareCredit.
- If you are unable to pay in full we offer in-office payment plans. A Financial Agreement will be put in place prior your procedure. If you set up a payment plan with our office the following terms will apply:
 - A minimum of 50% of the total cost of treatment is due the day of your procedure.
 - The remaining balance will be made in monthly installments over a period of 3 months or 6 months.
 - Monthly payments will be made using a credit or debit card. Cash or check may not be used for monthly payments.
 - A card number will be kept on file and payments will be automatically charged monthly for the duration of your payment plan.
 - If your account is not paid off in full by the date specified in your Financial Agreement the balance on your account will be sent to collections.

INSURANCE

We are considered an out-of-network provider with all insurance carriers. Many insurance plans have out-of-network benefits, and we will file your claim as a courtesy at the time of your visit. Your insurance contract exists solely between you and your insurance carrier and we are not responsible for the limitations and exclusions determined by your plan.

Any payments made by your insurance carrier will be sent to our office. If the combined payments from you and/or your insurance carrier result in a positive balance (credit) on your account, you will be refunded the overpayment.
